## Staff Profile Highlights



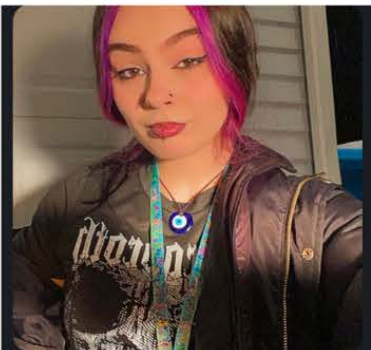
### Michael Dardas
